#### THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE PROGRAM

Saint John High School, with 25 of its teachers instructing International Baccalaureate courses, is graduating its 15th class of Diploma Candidates. Thirteen students opted for this rigorous academic program and hope to receive their diplomas in July. This will bring to 142 the number of Saint John High School students who hold this prestigious international credential. In addition 67 students wrote IB certificate exams this year and over 100 other students in grades 10 and 11 are preparing to write exams next year. These students have actively participated in all facets of school and community life, comprising the majority of the positions on the executive of the student council and yearbook, and holding key positions in drama productions and on sports teams.

Aside from the students currently involved in the IB program, over 1000 students have been involved in taking IB certificates since the program began, and our results remain at or above the world average in most subjects. Enrollment in the program continues to enable our students to compete for entrance to universities outside the Atlantic provinces. In the 2001 class, IB students have been accepted to the London School of Economics, the American School in Paris, Princeton, MIT and several Ontario universities.

Previous Diploma and Certificate holders have now graduated from their undergraduate university programs or from post-graduate studies and have begun to enter the work force. For example, the ten Diploma holders of 1988 consist of three PhD's, two medical doctors, a Master's in Health Administration, a teacher, a Master's of Law, a double Master's in Patent Law and Biochemistry in the field of genetics, and a Master's of Civil Engineering. Many of the IB graduates have received significant awards, ranging from top named scholarships to O'Brien fellowships to three Rhodes scholarships.
